

MINISTRY OF CITIZENSHIP AND IMMIGRATION GRANT

The 2 pilot communities are Social Planning Council of Kitchener-Waterloo and York Info Community Information & Volunteer Database, while the testing pilot site is Findhelp Information Services.

In 2014, the project completed its Year 2 goals in February, and began dashing towards the end goal of Year 3 deliverables by December.

To-date, there have been 60+ volunteers from 71 organizations involved in various aspects of the project, from testing the curriculum in the modules to local advisory groups.

Most of the communication pieces were started late in Year 2 to support the successful engagement of stakeholders in the two pilot communities and within the testing community. More work is required to more fully engage current and future stakeholders into the process and to educate them on the value of both the local resources and the training modules. Communication tools will be an important component in Year 3.

This project will certaining support individual practitioners who could use the training modules toward obtaining or maintaining a professional designation (Certificated Information and Referral Specialist or Certified Resource Specialist credentials available through related professional association). This, in turn, supports the professional capacity of organizations within each sector.

As Year 3 wraps up in 2015, more promotional materials and tools will become available.
